In the **Meadow**, you'll find lots of birds and butterflies flying among the grasses. There are a lot of cool insects to look for too!

Enjoy the beauty, quiet, and wildlife found along the **Forest Walk**.

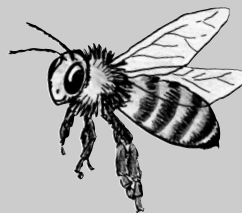

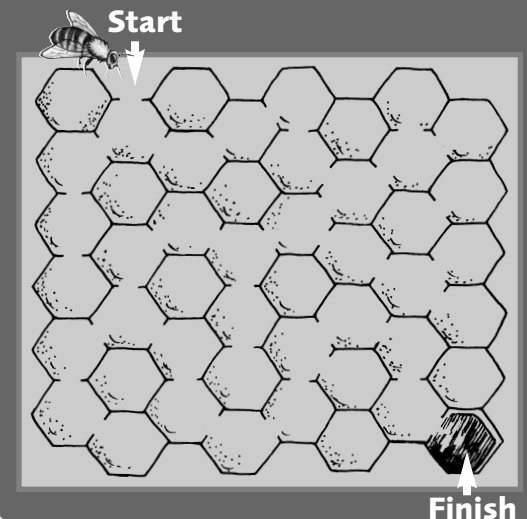
